**ORDINANCE NO. 01-2014**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 03-2004 ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE CERTAIN BUSINESSES AND ENTERPRISES IN THE BOROUGH OF NORTHVALE AND ESTABLISH A FEE THEREFORE”**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Board of Health of the Borough of Northvale that Section 213-1 Code of the Borough of Ordinance as amended by Ordinance #91-2 be amended as follows:

Section 1. The following businesses and enterprises conducted within the Borough of Northvale shall be required to secure a license and shall pay the fee as set forth. Failure to obtain a renewal of an established license in the month of January in any calendar year for existing establishments and for failure to obtain a retail food license before any new establishment opens for business, a late fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) will be imposed for licenses valued at one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and below fifty dollars (\$50.00) for all licenses valued at above one hundred dollars (\$100.00), as follows:

Section 2.      All other sections of this section shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3.      All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

Section 4.      This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage and publication according to law.
