Richard Scaglione – Beautification Committee –

Mr. Scaglione – Stated that he would like to make some improvement to the west side of park by the pond. He is planning on planting native plants on perimeter of the path to bring birds and butterflies. He feels that there is a lot of grant money is available as these plants will be zero scape plants in that they don't need a lot of water in order to survive. He stated that he has plants in his green house that he is donating to the park and he will need a little help from the DPW; 90% of the work will be done by volunteers.

Cheryl Johnson Shepard spoke about the project. She feels that this work will not fall under the umbrella of the Centennial. She also feels that with the help of the groups in town, girl scouts, boy scouts and school children this could be a great community project. The Borough Clerk will supply Mrs. Shepard with the grant writer information in order to determine what kinds of grants are available for this type of project.

WHEREAS, the Boroughs of Alpine, Closter, Haworth, Harrington Park, Norwood, Northvale and Rockleigh collectively operate the Interboro Regional Police Communications Network originally formed under the Interlocal Services Act (N.J.S.A. 40:8a-1 at seq.), herein after referred to as ("Interboro"); and

WHEREAS, the current structure of providing 9-1-1 Public Safety Answering Points ("PSAP") and Public Safety Dispatch Points ("PSDP") has resulted in a system in which increasing costs are being imposed upon municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the increasing costs of the current system have resulted in Public Safety organizations looking to participate in a unified and consolidated system; and

WHEREAS, in the densely populated Bergen County, this consolidation and shared infrastructure will result in direct savings to municipalities while increasing the performance and service levels on behalf of the operating entity; and

WHEREAS, consolidation will reduce or eliminate 9-1-1 call transfers between answering points and dispatch points, which improves response times whereby enhanced call processing should result in faster on-scene times for first responders; and

WHEREAS, a consolidated environment offers the opportunity for municipalities to benefit from state-of-the-art technology; and

WHEREAS, sharing resources and reducing costs is a driving principle behind consolidation which eliminates duplicate purchasing costs, reduce staffing costs and reduce comprehensive training costs; and

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Department of Public Safety currently operates a state-of-the-art Public Safety Communications Center and has the capability to provide 9-1-1 communications and dispatch services to the municipalities throughout Bergen County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement will provide for the payment of \$290,000 annually by the Interboro, payable in quarterly installments of \$72,500 on February 1, May 1, August 1, and November 1 of each year; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council's intent is that the Interboro Regional Communications Network will continue to function despite any relocation and will be more formally organized as a legal entity; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Northvale is desirous of having the County of Bergen provide said services to the Borough of Northvale.

1. That said agreement shall be for a period of five (5) years commencing on January 1, 2016 and ending on December 31, 2020 at an annual payment of \$295,000 to be paid by Interboro in quarterly installments of \$73,750 each on February 1, May 1, August 1 and November 1 of each year;

2. The Borough Administrator, Borough Attorney and Chief of Police or their designees, be and hereby are authorized and directed to negotiate the specific terms of

the contract to be entered into with the County of Bergen subject to final review of the Mayor and Council;

3. That the Mayor and Council support the continuation of the Interboro Regional Communications Network and its more formal organization/formation as a legally recognized entity to act as a contracting unit for its members.

Section 2. In addition to the compensation set forth in Section 1, each full time member of the Police Department hired before January 1, 2012, shall receive longevity pay as follows:

- 2% of annual base pay after 7 years of service
- 4% of annual base pay after 10 years of service
- 6% of annual base pay after 13 years of service
- 8% of annual base pay after 17 years of service
- 10% of annual base pay after 21 years of service

The following longevity schedule will take effect for all employees hired after January 1, 2012:

- 1.5% of annual base pay after 8 years of service
- 3% of annual base pay after 10 years of service
- 5% of annual base pay after 13 years of service
- 8% of annual base pay after 17 years of service
- 10% of annual base pay after 21 years of service

If an employee reaches a higher plateau of longevity entitlement at any time during the calendar year, then said employee shall be entitled to receive the full value of the higher plateau.

Section 3. Time in excess of the basic work week or tour for a day performed by a Lieutenant, Sergeant or Patrolman shall be compensated for at the rate of time and one-half.

Section 4. Each full-time member of the Police Department under Contract shall receive a lump sum compensation for thirteen (13) holidays, payable between December 1 and 5, 2016

Section 5. There shall be paid to each full-time member of the Police Department during the year of attainment of college credits towards a Police Science Degree and in each year of service thereafter the sum of:

\$ 300.00 upon completion of 25 credits

\$ 600.00 upon completion of 45 credits
 \$1,000.00 upon completion of an Associate's Degree
 \$1,500.00 upon completion of a Bachelor's Degree

Where an employee qualifies for a higher plateau of credits during the first half of a calendar year (January 1 through June 30), then said employee shall be entitled to higher educational incentive payments starting the first day of July 1 of that same year and in each year of service thereafter. In the event that an Employee qualifies for a higher plateau of credits during the last half of the calendar year (July 1 through December 31), then the entitlement to higher educational compensation shall commence with the following January 1 and in each year of service thereafter.

Section 6. All full time employees of the Police Department shall be paid bi-weekly.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage and publication according to law.

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Section 2. In addition to the compensation set forth in Section 1, each full time employee of the Borough of Northvale shall receive longevity pay as follows:

EMPLOYEES HIRED BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1995

- 2% of the base annual pay after 5 years of service
- 4% of the base annual pay after 9 years of service
- 6% of the base annual pay after 13 years of service
- 8% of the base annual pay after 17 years of service
- 10% of the base annual pay after 21 years of service

EMPLOYEES HIRED AFTER JANUARY 1, 1995

Effective January 1, 1995, longevity pay will no longer be granted to any employees hired after January 1, 1995.

This shall be paid in two installments with first pay check in July and first pay check in December of each year, and is not to exceed \$7,500.00 in any one year.

Section 3. The Superintendent of Public Works will designate a member of the Department each week to be available on a Saturday, Sunday or Holiday. Such time will be classified as "Stand By" time and shall be paid at the rate of \$200.00 per day.

Section 4. Each new and existing employee of the Department of Public Works shall receive \$1,800.00, effective January 1, 2016 for clothing allowance. Clothing allowance shall be paid by separate check in 2 (two) equal installments. The 1st (first) payment shall be in the 1st (first) pay period of each year and the 2nd (second) payment shall be during the 1st (first) pay period in July of each year.

Section 5. Time in excess of forty (40) hours per week for all full time employees is to be paid at the rate of time and one-half.

Section 6. All full time employees of the Department of Public Works shall be paid bi-weekly.

Section 7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage and publication according to law.

Ms. Kathleen deFillipis – Rio Vista Lane – commented that the trash company has been picking up garbage and recycling in the same truck. She stated that she called them and they stated that they separate the items once they get to the transfer station. She was further concerned with the traffic on Industrial Parkway. She would like to see speed limit signs and striping on the street to keep the drivers and in particular the trucks on their proper side of the street. Mr. Bodrato, Superintendent of Public Works stated that he would speak with the Chief of Police tomorrow.

Mr. Bill Hughes - Thanked the Mayor and Council for passing the resolutions on their tax appeals.

There being no further questions or comments from the public; Mayor Piehler closed the public hearing at 8:15 PM.

MAYOR & COUNCIL COMMENTS –

Councilman Michael Small –

Board of Education; NVRHS; Grants; Recreation Parks, Open Space & Playgrounds; Golden Age Club

Councilman Small reported that he has been in communication with the President of the Golden Age Club. They have given him their anticipated expenses for the year, which he submitted to Councilman Marana for budget consideration.

Councilman Small further reported that Recreation is looking at purchasing a new scoreboard for field #4. He stated that the cost is between \$6,200 and \$6,500 and it is solar powered. The cost will be charged to the banner account.

He further reported that Recreation is looking into a Waiver for coaches. He stated that presently parents sign one for children. He further reported on the on-line concussion training with the coaches. They are also looking into CPR Training as well. He anticipates that Opening day this year will be on April 23.

Councilman Pat Marana –

Finance & Taxation; Building Department; Emergency Management; Flood Committee & Zoning Department

Councilman Marana stated that the building department has exceeded the amount anticipated for revenue for this year. He further stated that the installation dinners for the fire department and ambulance corps were very nice. He complimented that DPW on the great job done during the recent snow storm.

Councilman Ken Shepard –

Department of Public Works; Buildings and Grounds; Fire Department; Fire Prevention

Councilman Shepard reported on the status of the DPW Equipment. He stated that there is only one truck with a hook lift at this point in time and that the DPW is looking at converting and refurbishing the garbage truck so that it too will have a hook lift. He stated that it would cost \$250,000 for a new truck and that the conversion will cost a lot less. Mr. Bodrato also stated that the body of the garbage truck can be sold to another company for a price of \$25,000 - \$30,000.

Councilman Roy Sokoloski –

Planning Board; Board of Health; Pre-school; Insurance, Safety & Risk Management, Licenses and Permits

Councilman Sokoloski reported on the closed session meeting that the Planning/Zoning Board had with the planner. He feels that they are going in the right direction.

Councilman Sokoloski further reported that the Board of Health made a major change this year in that they have chosen to change to the Bergen County Board of Health for services. It was a savings of quite a bit of money. They will be monitoring the service that they receive and if they are happy, they can choose to stay with them.

Councilman Sokoloski further reported that he met with Mrs. Moses with regard to there not being a sign telling people where the preschool is. They discussed a sign that can be put up at the Borough Hall. He will follow up with Mrs. Moses in the near future for the ideal location of the sign.

Councilwoman Toni Macchio –

Beautification Committee; Municipal Library; Cultural Arts Committee; Community Affairs; Chamber of Commerce; Northvale Senior Center

Councilwoman Macchio reported that Senior Center is having their Valentines Party on Tuesday, February 16 @ noon. The price is \$12.00 per person and \$15.00 at the door. She stated that there will be food, drink and entertainment.

Councilman Peter Sotiropoulos –

Police Department; Ambulance Corps; Public Safety and Municipal Court

Councilman Sotiropoulos reported that the Police Department now has a facebook page. He stated that it is very informative – like the page and follow the postings for the latest news. He further reported on the Ambulance Corps statistics for the past month and noted that the installation dinner was great.

BOROUGH ENGINEER REPORT –

Mr. O’Brien reported on the various activities that he has been involved with over the past month. He stated that the Paris Avenue Streetscape should start on or about April 1. He further reported that he is locating the vendors who installed the light stanchions on Livingston Street and he anticipates that they will be worked on soon.

BOROUGH ATTORNEY REPORT –

Mr. Shahdanian, II, Esq., reported that the Hirshberg litigation has been dismissed against the Borough. He stated that the lease for the American Legion is being worked on as we speak and that the ratio issue has been settled with the tax court and the ratio is now 91.02%. This information has been provided to the Division of Local Government Services, therefore, the library portion amount this year should be readjusted.
