WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the governing body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, as per the regulations of the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the promulgations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52 - to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52 - "A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction may be fined not more than one thousand

dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.”

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTHVALE, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Capital Improvement of the Conversion of a Garbage Truck is hereby authorized as a general capital improvement to be undertaken by the Borough. There is hereby appropriated the amount of \$90,000.00 for said improvement or purpose.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$90,000.00 is hereby provided from Capital Fund Surplus and appropriated for the purposes in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Said improvements are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement, no part of which shall be assessed against a property specifically benefitted.

SECTION 4. No Supplemental Debt Statement is required, since this ordinance does not authorize the issuance of any debt.

SECTION 5. The Capital Budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and a resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital programs as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs is on file in the Office of the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Councilman Marana - Reported on the activity of the Building Department for the month. He stated that Cho Dae will be starting their work in the near future and that will be bringing more revenue.

He distributed a work sheet detailing the capital purchases that the Departments would like to make. The Mayor and Council asked a few questions and Councilman Marana explained. He stated that he also put in a beginning amount for the beginning of the DPW Building.

Councilman Sokoloski stated that he had major questions with regard to the DPW building as far as the actual funding needed to complete the project and he would like to see the actual design of the building.

It was decided that decisions on the DPW building will be made once Maser Consulting has done the work/planning that they intend to do by the next meeting.

Councilman Small further reported that he has had a meeting with the school with regard to the condition of the soccer field that was funded with Open Space dollars and in cooperation with the Borough of Northvale. He stated that Mr. Pinajian has received a quote of \$28,900 to repair the field and the school is looking to split the repair of the costs with the Borough. He further stated that he will be having a discussion with Ms. Scavone of Millenium as they prepared the grant for this project to get a feel of how this occurred and how it will be resolved.

Councilman Shepard - Reported on the fire prevention activity for the month. He further reported that the fire department and DPW have been quiet this past month.

Councilman Sokoloski – Reported that he will be attending the COAH matter in Court on Thursday.

BOROUGH ENGINEER REPORT –

Ms. Mullen reported on the various projects. The DPW Oil-Water Separator project is nearing completion. The Gazebo at Hogan Park is under construction and should be delivered on or about September 30th. The subdivision plan for 411 Clinton

has been completed, additional options may be available. Paris Ave Streetscape and 2016 Riverside Co-op are completed. Ms. Mullen is reviewing to see if additional funds are available to pave additional roadways. Weekly monitoring at Tect/Danzig, ADA Shop Rite Liquors, continues. The draft remedial investigation report for groundwater at Deluxe Cleaners has been completed. Groundwater sampling data at the DPW indicated the contaminant concentrations were below the State Groundwater Quality Standards. The investigation at the White Avenue Pump Station has been completed. Maser will coordinate with Sue Scavone of Millenium Strategies on various municipal grants. Ms. Mullen met with the DPW and Police Chief regarding various upgrades throughout the Borough.

Mr. Shahdanian stated that the only matter that he has to discuss is for closed session.

MAYOR’S REPORT –

Mayor Piehler stated that there will be a ribbon cutting for St. Anthony’s new apartments in the near future.
