BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Northvale that Section 166-3 of the Code be amended as follows:

Section 1. That Section 166-3 be amended to include the following:

166-3 PERMIT APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR MINOR SOIL MOVEMENTS.

That a new section 166-3 – F. be added to read:

“The Borough Engineer, upon receipt of the Minor Soil application, shall make a field inspection and shall issue the permit or deny it, giving his/her reasons for such denial in writing. The Borough Engineer shall forward a copy of the approval/denial letter to the Construction Official, Borough Clerk and the applicant and shall retain a copy on file. The Borough Engineer may classify any Minor Soil Movement application as a Major Soil Movement application if he/she determines that the application poses a substantial drainage problem or adversely affects the adjoining contiguous lot or lots. Such a determination will trigger compliance by the application with all provisions governing Major Soil Movement Permits.”

The addition of wording under Minor Soil Movement, “and when lower amounts of soil over 50 cubic yards of soil are moved, the following wording be added:

**“No stormwater improvements required if:**

1. No substantial change to grading with the backing setbacks is proposed
2. All runoff is directed to the interior of the site
3. All roof runoff is captured by leaders
4. Improved lot coverage pursuant to Northvale Zoning Code increases 500 square feet or less”

**“If stormwater improvements are required the applicant shall:**

1. Construct on-site stormwater management system to accommodate two inches of runoff for the area of proposed improvements
2. Ensure that no increase in runoff occurs on any adjoining property.

That upon review of application for a Minor Soil Movement Permit by the Borough Engineer, the applicant shall post escrow in an amount to be determined by the Engineers office for said review.

Section 2. That Section 166-13 of the Code “Definitions” change “Major Soil Movement” to “Minor Soil Movement”.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 4. All other parts of Chapter 166 of the Code of the Borough of Northvale not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

**MAYOR & COUNCIL REPORTS –**

Councilman Sotiropoulos - reported that the Junior Police Academy was a success. He stated that it has been run for years by Sgt. Rob Pizzi and that he is ready to pass the reins off to Patrolman Charles Albanese. He thanks Sgt. Pizzi for the excellent job that he has done over the years and wishes Patrolman Albanese success in the future. He further reported that the Cho Dae Golf Outing will take place sometime in September and the proceeds are generously donated to the fire departments of Northvale and Norwood and the Ambulance Corps of Northvale and Norwood. Lastly, Councilman Sotiropoulos reported on the statistics of the Ambulance Corps for the past month. He stated that it was a busy month for calls.

Councilman DeLisio – reported that he has attended the Board meetings at the Regional High School and the Northvale Schools. He stated that nothing much is going on other than Mr. Pinajian received a new three year contract.

Councilman Small – reported that the building department proceeds for the past month was \$13,500. He stated that they are just shy of \$100,000 for year.

Councilwoman Macchio – reported on the activities of the Library for the month. She stated that the hot dog social at the Senior Center is coming up in the near future and is just about sold out. She further reported that the Beautification Committee is finished planting at Hogan Park and is awaiting the installation of sprinklers in the very near future.

Councilman Shepard – reported on the fire prevention inspections for the past month and also the various activities of the Department of Public Works.

Councilman Sokoloski – reported that he attended the CDBG meeting held in Dumont. Last year the Borough received \$38,000 for the Operation of the Senior Center. That amount has been cut to \$35,000 for this year. He said that he feels that we are lucky as we are the only town that applies for and receives such a big amount of funding. He further reported that the Planning/Zoning Board has been quiet this past month.

**BOROUGH ENGINEER REPORTS –**

Sunny Mullen – reported that the work on Livingston Street Streetscape is moving along and that there haven't been any issues that needed addressing. She stated that the project will be wrapped up as soon as possible. She reported that the Riverside Cooperative Road Resurfacing Project has been completed, again with no major issues being reported. She reported that a concept plan for the Clinton Avenue railroad crossing project is being developed for submission. Funding of the project was discussed and the only costs that wouldn't be covered under the grant are for engineering fees. She stated that she would have an amount for the 2017 Bond Ordinance for the engineering fees for the entire project as soon as possible. She reported that they are still working on the lighting plan for Hogan Park for the lights being donated by RAB Lighting. She would also have that plan as soon as possible. They are looking at obtaining prices for

installation of the lights by an electrician. PSE & G is still actively working on Paris Avenue and hopefully that portion of the project will be wrapped up soon.
