The amount is based on what is in our County contract for snow removal. She further stated that the Riverside Cooperative has met with the County Superintendent of Public Works at their last meeting. Based on the data supplied to him by the member towns, he felt that it would be fair to ask the County Executive to raise the price from \$90.00 per hour to \$100.00 or \$105.00 per hour. That would enable the Borough to charge more to Rockleigh for our Snow Plowing services.

Paul Iullo – Bradley Avenue – Thanked Roy for serving the community. Thanks for taking care of the crossing guards who are also seniors. He thought that it might be a good idea to write to the company who sold the crossing guard signs to the Borough to get the money back as they do not meet the specifications for use by Crossing Guards.
