





November 12: Rain Man (Starring Tom Cruise & Dustin Hoffman)

When car dealer Charlie Babbitt learns that his estranged father has died, he returns home to Cincinnati, where he discovers that he has an autistic older brother named Raymond and that his father's \$3 million fortune is being left to the mental institution in which Raymond lives. Motivated by his father's money, Charlie checks Raymond out of the facility in order to return with him to Los Angeles. The brothers' cross-country trip ends up changing both their lives.

(1988) Rated: R - Comedy/Action - 2 hr 13 min

November 19: What's Eating Gilbert Grape (Starring Johnny Depp & Leonardo DiCaprio)

Gilbert Grape is a small-town young man with a lot of responsibility. Chief among his concerns are his mother, who is so overweight that she can't leave the house, and his mentally impaired younger brother, Arnie, who has a knack for finding trouble. Settled into a job at a grocery store and an ongoing affair with local woman Betty Carver, Gilbert finally has his life shaken up by the free-spirited Becky.

(1993) Rated: PG-13 – Comedy/Drama – 1 hr 58 min

Struggling to build relationships with others, a teenage math prodigy with autism develops a budding friendship with a young girl while competing at the International Mathematics Olympiad.

Here are the 3 ways you can vote in the upcoming General Election...

1. AT YOUR POLLING PLACE ON ELECTION DAY



Vote in person at your polling place, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 5. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

Go to VOTE.NJ.GOV for your polling place, listed on the Polling Locations page.

2. IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING



This option enables all registered voters to cast their ballot in person, using a voting machine, during a nine-day period prior to Election Day. You can choose to vote, in person, when it's most convenient for your schedule.

No matter where you live in the county, you can vote your specific ballot at any of **your** county's designated in-person early voting sites. Find your county's sites at **VOTE.NJ.GOV**.

In-person early voting sites will be open Saturday, October 26 through Sunday, November 3. Hours will be Monday-Saturday, 10:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. and Sunday, 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

3. VOTE BY MAIL



Registered voters can apply for a **mail-in ballot** by following the instructions found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV** or contacting their County Clerk.

Then, VOTE and RETURN your ballot one of the following ways...



- Secure Ballot Drop Box: Place your mail-in ballot in one of your county's secure ballot drop boxes by 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5. Drop box locations can be found at VOTE.NJ.GOV.
- Board of Elections Office: Deliver your mail-in ballot in person to your county's Board of Elections Office by 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5. County Election Officials' contact information can be found at VOTE.NJ.GOV.
- Mail: Your mail-in ballot MUST be postmarked on or before 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5
 and be received by your county's Board of Elections on or before Monday, November 11.






1... Be sure you're registered to vote. Check your registration status using the Am I Registered? link at VOTE.NJ.GOV.



2... Verify your polling place using the Polling Location link at VOTE.NJ.GOV or by contacting your County Clerk. Contact information is available at VOTE.NJ.GOV.



3... Check in at the registration table at your polling place.

4... Sign the electronic poll book, after which you will be issued your ballot.



5... Depending on your county, you will be directed to either a voting machine or provided with a paper ballot and directed to a private booth.



6... Read the instructions for each section and complete your ballot carefully. Some races ask you to mark more than one candidate. If you wish to leave a race blank, you may do so without affecting any other portion of your ballot.

NOTE: Paper ballots may have more than one side or page, so look carefully to be sure you vote for each race you intend to. **Cross-outs on paper ballots will render the ballot invalid.** If you wish to make a change to your paper ballot before casting it, take your ballot to a poll worker to receive a new paper ballot.



7... If you have any concerns regarding your ballot, including if it is smudged or damaged, tell a poll worker to ensure your voting choices can and will be counted.



8... Once you complete these steps, your ballot is ready to go into the ballot box or tabulating machine, depending on the tabulation process used by your polling place.
