July 2: The King's Speech (Starring Colin Firth & Helena Bonham Carter)

England's Prince Albert must ascend the throne as King George VI, but he has a speech impediment. Knowing that the country needs her husband to be able to communicate effectively, Elizabeth hires Lionel Logue, an Australian actor and speech therapist, to help him overcome his stammer. An extraordinary friendship develops between the two men, as Logue uses unconventional means to teach the monarch how to speak with confidence.



Rumbledethumps

PREP TIME: 15 MIN COOKING TIME: 45 MIN SERVES: 6

While away in Scotland, I learned of Rumbledethumps. This peculiarly named dish comes from the southern area of Scotland that borders England. The name comes from the rumble and thumps of the veggies as you lay them all on the counter. A vegetablebased side with just a handful of ingredients, it seemed like the perfect dish to share with you all. Give it a try and transport yourself to Scotland. Enjoy! -Michelle

- Ingredients
- 1lb 5oz large potatoes, peeled and chopped into large chunks
- 14 oz turnips, peeled and chopped into large chunks
- 3 oz butter
 9 oz cabbage or kale,
- finely sliced
 salt and freshly ground black pepper
 1 oz cheddar, grated

- Directions
- 1. Preheat the oven to 350°F.
- 2. Cook the potatoes and turnips in a saucepan with salted boiling water until tender. Drain well and return to the pan.
 3. Heat 2 oz butter in a pan and gently cook the cabbage for a few minutes, until the cabbage is tender but retains its color.
 4. Add the cabbage to the pan with the potatoes and turnips. Add the remaining 1 oz butter and mash together using a potato masher. Season to taste with salt and freshly ground black pepper.
- 5. Place the mashed vegetables into an ovenproof lidded dish and top with the cheese. Cover with a lid and bake in the oven for about 30 minutes, then remove the lid and continue to cook for a further 15 minutes, or until piping hot and goldenbrown on top.
